A very interesting joint presentation today, from Brittany (Wellbeing Service) and Mimi (Changes), giving an overview of the mental wellbeing triggers to look out for {stress, anxiety, low mood} as well as coping mechanisms (both helpful and unhelpful!).

There was a lot of discussion and sharing from the group, demonstrating what an important topic this is for all of us today. Two key slides:

- Support from family and friends
- Attending appointments
- Using medication appropriately
- Relaxation
- Socialising
- Hobbies
- Exercise
- Balance and routine
- Journaling

There are things YOU can do to help yourself

- Actively engage in your care
- Self monitor - check in with yourself
- Challenge your thoughts - ask yourself “are they helpful to me in this moment?”
- Behaviourally - ask yourself “what CAN I do?”
- Pace yourself - limit boom and bust behaviours
- Set reasonable achievable goals - prioritising one thing at a time
- Give yourself the advice you would give a friend in your situation - don't be so hard on yourself
- Lapses are normal! - catch yourself and practice what works

17:00 Leave Llandudno from the coach drop-off point

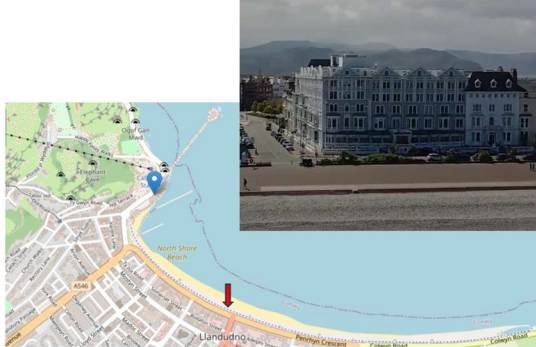

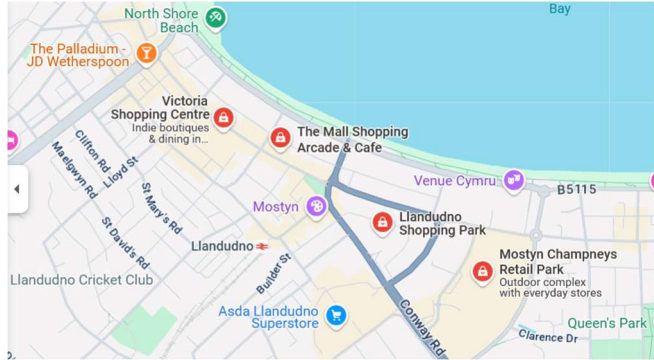
